

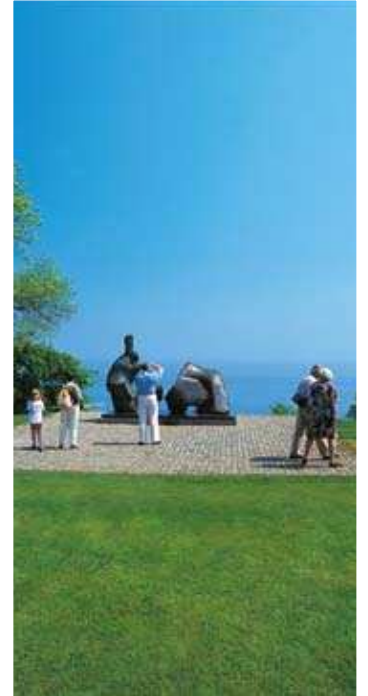

WELCOME TO HELSINGBORG/EL SINORE! TWO COUNTRIES – ONE DESTINATION



The twin cities of Helsingborg in Sweden and Elsinore (Helsingør in Danish) in Denmark – at the narrowest part of the strait of Öresund – give you the opportunity to visit two countries in one day. They have not always been two countries: up until 350 years ago, it was Danish territory on both sides of Öresund. The two sides share the same history but, if you look closely, you will discover the similarities and the differences between the Danes and Swedes.

It's easy to travel between Helsingborg and Elsinore; the ferry trip only takes twenty minutes and no passport is needed. Every year, millions of passengers travel between these twin towns, for pleasure as well as for business and, each year, this commuting increases. Why not have a shopping trip in both countries on the same day? It couldn't be easier! This is quite a tradition for the people of Helsingborg and Elsinore. In many shops, Danish and Swedish currency as well as Euros are accepted – just ask!

In this part of the Öresund region you will find an exciting mix that includes history, culture, nature, and gastronomy. Royal residences and old farm-houses, modern art museums and traditional handicrafts, dramatic cliffs, peaceful beechwoods and long stretches of sandy shore. They all meet here.

Join a tour and see the creative activity among our local potters, glass artists, weavers and other craftspeople. Visit the famous Louisiana Museum of Modern Art or feel a touch of royalty at the history-soaked palaces and castles. A visit to Kronborg Castle, famous as the backdrop of Shakespeare's "Hamlet", is a must.

Enjoy strolling round magnificent gardens filled with rhododendrons and roses in full bloom or taste the culinary delights of the region such as the traditional Danish "smørrebrød" open sandwiches.

Do it the Elsinore-Helsingborg way – enjoy two countries in one day!

MONARCHY AND DEMOCRACY

Denmark and Sweden are both monarchies. The head of state is the monarch, who is without political power and does not take part in politics. The monarch's function is ceremonial and formal: conducting state visits to other countries and acting as host/hostess at state visits in their own countries. Queen Margrethe II is the monarch in Denmark and King Carl XVI Gustaf in Sweden. They are also related (cousins). Denmark and Sweden are parliamentary democracies. The head of government is the prime minister. Denmark has 5.4 million inhabitants and Sweden 9.01 million. The population of Elsinore is 61,000, with twice as many, 121,000, living in Helsingborg.

CURRENCY AND THE EUROPEAN UNION (EU)

Denmark and Sweden are members of the EU, but they have not joined the monetary union. Thus the currency of Denmark is still the Danish Krone (DKK) while Sweden's is the Swedish Krona (SEK). 1 Krone/Krona is divided into 100 Øre/Öre.

100 DKK = about EUR 13 or USD 17

100 SEK = about EUR 9 or USD 11

In many shops, both Danish and Swedish currency is accepted, as well as the Euro – just ask! Credit cards are usually accepted.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE AND VAT

Visitors with credit cards can obtain cash from cash dispensers located outside many banks. Foreign exchange is handled by banks (normally open 10am – 3pm on weekdays) or at foreign exchanges offices (normally open 9am – 7pm). VAT on goods bought in the Öresund region is refundable if the purchaser is from outside the EU. Ask for a Tax Free form when making purchases.

LANGUAGE

Danish and Swedish are very similar (as is Norwegian) and Danes and Swedes usually understand each other's languages. Most people understand English.

ELECTRICITY AND DRINKING WATER

The voltage in the Öresund area is 210 V. Tap water in the region is safe to drink.

SAFETY

Helsingborg, Elsinore and the areas around them are generally regarded as safe, but they attract many visitors during summer. Beware of pickpockets, especially in crowded areas.

EMERGENCY ALARM / SOS 112

Call 112 in case of emergency. Ask for ambulance, doctor/ dentist on duty, fire brigade, police, air or sea rescue.

NOW AND THEN

The bonds between Denmark and Sweden are strong. The Royal Families for instance are closely related. Queen Margrethe II of Denmark and King Carl XVI Gustaf of Sweden are cousins and have spent many summers together at the former Royal residence of Sofiero outside Helsingborg. The picture to the left shows both Royal Houses at the 100 year celebration of Sofiero in 2005. On the right picture from 1874 the first owners of the Castle, King Oscar II of Sweden and his family.

FREDRIKSDAL AND SOFIERO GARDENS

Visit Fredriksdal Museums and Gardens and enjoy the beauty and scents of the wonderful rose garden and botanical garden. In the unique landscape garden you will witness all the variations of the countryside of Skåne and you can find out the history of the mansion and the old town quarters. At Sofiero Palace and Gardens, a former royal summer residence, your guided tour will take you through the rhododendron ravine, in full bloom in May-June, and along the paths beside Crown princess Margareta's magnificent flower borders.

GREENERY AND PEACE IN SÖDERÅSEN NATIONAL PARK

Your guide will take you on a walk and explain about the national park and how the ravine was created. This is one of the largest uninterrupted stretches of protected broad-leaved forest in northern Europe. Wonderful view from the Kopparhatten plateau. Coffee break at a typical Swedish inn with history from the 19th century. Stop at Klippans Yllefabrik factory shop where you will find high quality Swedish products of the finest wool, linen and cotton.

KULLA PENINSULA TOUR



Drive along the coastline, through the picturesque fishing villages. Stop at Mölle, a seaside resort popular at the turn of the 19th century, renowned for the decadence that allowed men and women to bathe together! At the Kullaberg nature reserve you will visit northern Europe's brightest lighthouse. A guide will take you on a walk exploring the cliffs and visiting two caves (not suited for the disabled). End your tour with a coffee break at the Flickorna Lundgren café, famed for their vanilla heart cakes.

EXPLORE THE ISLAND OF VEN ON A BIKE



The best way to experience the island of Ven is by bike! Your guide will take you along paths to old farmhouses, natural wonders and interesting little shops. A visit to the Tycho Brahe Heritage is also included, where you will hear about this famous astronomer's life.

LANDBORGEN – WAFFLES AND A DIP IN THE SEA



See Helsingborg from a height, walking along the ridge above the city. Guided tour through parks and past private gardens, with the strait of Öresund and the Danish coastline in constant view. Coffee break with waffles at the café in the Pålsjö woods. Take a dip in the sea at the Pålsjö sea bathing facility – no swimsuit needed! – before returning via the sandy beach and the impressive new marina.

ACTIVITIES



CITY WALKING TOUR OF HELSINGBORG AND/OR ELSINORE 

Enjoy a historical guided walk through the centre of Helsingborg or Elsinore. Each city walk takes an hour. Combine the tours and discover the similarities and the differences between these twin towns, and enjoy the ferry ride across the strait.

The Kullaberg peninsula is a climber's paradise! Walking, sea kayaking and riding are popular here too. The RIB speedboats for groups are used on seal safaris as well as for transportation. An outing to Nimis, the driftwood sculpture on the north side of the peninsula, is always popular destination.

RAMLÖSA BRUNNSPARK 

The Ramlösa Spa in Helsingborg enjoyed its golden age in the 18th and 19th centuries. The public park with the original spring is open; take a walk and try the waters. Guided tour can be arranged

The Rothoffska Kolonin in Landskrona, founded in 1903, is Sweden's only allotment garden museum. The garden and the little cottage are open for visitors.

Privately owned mansion dating from 1633. Famous for the impressive boxwood hedges that Carl Linneaus admired during his travels in Skåne in the 1800s. The park is open to the public.

At the forefront in Denmark in the cultivation of all kinds of orchids. The nursery has over 3,000 m² of orchid-filled greenhouses that are heated with natural gas and geothermal energy. Guests are welcome.

SET SAIL ON ÖRESUND



Be a sailor for a day! Enjoy a memorable sail on the strait of Öresund, on a historical sailing ship. Set sail and try your hand at navigation, or just enjoy the sea breeze and the sounds from rig and ropes. A maritime lunch or dinner may be served and, to remind you of your experience as a sailor, the captain will award you with a certificate.

FISHERMAN FOR A DAY (HELSINGBORG OR ELSINORE)



Embark on a fishing boat and head out for the open waters of Öresund. Depending on the season, you can find cod, herring and mackerel. You will be instructed by the crew on how to handle your fishing rod and you will then have the chance to try your luck. Feel tension building as you all stand along the rail wondering who will get the first catch, while trying not to get your fishing line tangled with your neighbours'. No previous experience required, only warm clothes. You keep your catch. Lunch on board.

ROYAL LIFE AT SOFIERO PALACE



Built as a royal summer residence in 1864, the Palace of Sofiero was later given as a wedding gift to Crown Prince Gustav Adolf and his wife Margareta in 1905. The young couple created a summer paradise for the royal family. Margareta died at a young age leaving King Gustav Adolf with five children. The King remarried, and his new wife Louise Mountbatten also had much influence on the family life at Sofiero. Guided tour describing the royal family life and that of the servants and farmers who worked on the estate and in the neighbourhood.

KRONBORG, HAMLET'S CASTLE IN ELSINORE



Kronborg Castle is inscribed on the World Heritage List as building of outstanding significance in the history of this area of northern Europe. This Renaissance castle, a military fortress surrounded by major fortifications, demonstrates the greatness of the Danish kingdom during that period. Feeling the atmosphere when walking through the Chapel and the Knight's Hall – the longest room in Northern Europe – it is easy to understand why Shakespeare chose Kronborg as the setting for “Hamlet”. Visit the Royal Chambers, the Councillors' Hall with the seven tapestries, the underground casemates and the statue of Holger the Dane.

CASTLE TOUR OF NORTH ZEALAND



Visit Kronborg, of Hamlet fame, a Renaissance castle and former military fortress overlooking the narrow strait of Oresund that divides Denmark from Sweden. The tour continues on to the royal family's summer residence – Fredensborg Palace – where you will visit the lovely baroque Nordmandsdalen sculpture park. In July alone, the private Reserved Gardens and the Orangery (at Fredensborg Palace), are open to the public for guided tours. The next stop is at Frederiksborg Castle. This exciting, historical gem, built in magnificent Renaissance style with a touch of baroque, now houses the National History Museum.

ROSKILDE CATHEDRAL AND THE VIKING SHIP MUSEUM



Roskilde Cathedral is inscribed on the World Heritage List as a building of outstanding significance in the history of this area of northern Europe. The church was begun by Bishop Absalon in the 1170s, with chapels in various styles having been added over the years. The Cathedral has been the mausoleum for the Danish royal family since the 15th century. Lunch at the Restaurant Snekken at the Roskilde Yacht Harbour. The Viking Ship Museum, beautifully situated by the Roskilde fjord, puts Viking times into perspective with a focus on the voyages of Havhingsten (The Sea Stallion) and other Viking ships.

BEHIND CLOSED DOORS AT THE HELSINGBORG TOWN HALL



Behind the decorative facade of the Town Hall are a magnificent stairwell and session chambers. Beautiful stained-glass windows illustrate important events from the history of Helsingborg.

KÄRNAN – THE KEEP



The tower overlooking the town is all that remains of Helsingborg Castle. The keep is 34 metres high and climbing the spiral staircase to the top is strenuous but rewarding - the view is magnificent.

SWEDISH ART & DESIGN



Enjoy a visit to Märta Måås-Fjätterström's weaving workshop. Her textiles can be found all over the world. Guided tour through the workshop where each rug is handmade. At Eldoluft Glass Studio the artist uses his own innovative techniques combined with traditional Swedish glassblowing methods. Continue to Café Killaröd for a coffee break including their speciality, apple meringue cake. Last stop is at the factory shop of Stearinljusfabriken, the candle factory.

FROM CLAY TO ART – EXPLORE THE CERAMICS REGION



This tour takes you to the Kullaberg peninsula and to Höganäs, the capital of the ceramics region. Visit Kullabygdens Keramik where you will be introduced to the ceramic-making process. Enjoy a coffee break at the delightful Krapperup Castle café before having a scenic tour of the Kullaberg peninsula and continuing on to the Höganäs Keramik littala factory outlet. Here you will find the famous Höganäs ceramics brand as well as a wide range of high-quality glassware.

DRAMATIC SCULPTURES AND MODERN ART

On this tour you will first visit the Rudolph Tegner Museum and see his colossal sculptures created in the art nouveau style of the early 1900s. The Danish sculptor Rudolph Tegner (1873-1950) strived for dramatic movement in his monumental style and these sculptures will not leave you unmoved. In Humlebæk you will enjoy lunch at a typical Danish inn before visiting Louisiana. Founded in the 1950s, this museum of modern art, architecture and landscape is a work of art in itself. Your guided tour takes you through the permanent or the current exhibition.

FROM DINOSAURS TO CERAMICS PRODUCTION

Sweden's oldest stoneware factory from 1864, still using the traditional techniques in a huge brick kiln fuelled with coal to produce the special salt-glazed finish.

LANDSKRONA CITADEL – FORTRESS, PRISON AND GARDEN



Landskrona Citadel was built in 1559 and served as a fortress for more than 250 years. It was later used as a jail for prisoners serving life sentence and for ‘fallen women’. Allotment gardens were laid around the Citadel as far back as the 1800s. A visit to the Citadel takes you from a setting of wars, defences and dungeons to a contrast of picturesque houses and flourishing allotment gardens.

THE CARMELITE MONASTERY AND SCT. MARIÆ CHURCH IN ELSINORE



The Carmelite Monastery is one of northern Europe’s best preserved monasteries and one of the major places of interest in Elsinore. The guided tour of the Monastery takes you to the cloisters, the music room and the refectory. In the Sct. Mariæ Church you will see the well-preserved murals and the newly renovated organ that Buxtehude, the German composer, used when he was organist here during the 1660s.

TYCHO BRAHE AND THE RENAISSANCE ASTRONOMY CENTRE



When Tycho Brahe (1546-1601) discovered a new star in 1572 he won fame all over Europe. He built his scientific centre on the island of Ven. Guided tour of the remains of his observatory. Hear about his life and scientific significance and see reconstructions of the instruments he made more than 400 years ago.

ACTIVITIES

NATIONAL DEFENSE DURING WORLD WAR II



Sweden's only World War II underground bunker museum is situated north of Helsingborg. The guided tour will show you how Swedish troops prepared their defence if the Germans were to attack from across the narrow strait. Hear about the life on the battery, about the links with the locals during the major alert, and about ordinary life. End your tour with a 'field lunch' of the traditional Swedish pea soup with mustard. **Duration:** 1 h

Birds of prey were used as hunting companions for Viking chieftains and kings until 1810. At Falkonergården you will see falcons swoop from great heights to just above your head, at a speed of 300 km/h!
